

COVID-19 US Senate Stimulus Package Information

We continue to receive updates from the moves of local, state, and federal responses working to address health and economic issues that have developed due to COVID-19. As most of you are aware, the Senate passed a stimulus package and that is now headed to the House of Representatives. The President has said he will quickly sign the package once it reaches his desk.

We will continue to monitor the actions of the bill as it moves through the House of Representatives and will share any breakdowns of the bill that we receive.
