Thank you for your interest in the Elkhart Leadership Academy sponsored by the Greater Elkhart Chamber of Commerce. Chamber member companies are invited to send an employee who has demonstrated a potential for leadership. In its 33rd year, the Elkhart Leadership Academy's nine-month program exposes each participant to key community issues and specific leadership capacities.

Over the last 32 years, the Elkhart Leadership Academy has been successful in making participants aware of the Elkhart Community. The curriculum involves both community awareness and leadership skill development.

The first three sessions will focus on key issues facing the Elkhart Community. The next three sessions will be designed to promote skill development in the following areas: problem solving, teambuilding, conflict management, and decision-making and communication skills. The final three sessions will combine both awareness and skill development by connecting participants to organizations currently working to address community issues. Participants will be involved in a group project, with completion requirements of May 2021, as well as serve a one-year board internship with a local nonprofit organization, if they have not participated in the past or are currently involved in a board or service club responsibility.

We ask that when you consider candidates from your organization, you look for someone who has demonstrated a potential for leadership and growth.
